Volunteer Task Force – Your Village Needs You!

Following the Annual Parish Meeting on 4 April 2016 when it was noted that there was an increasing problem of littering within the village, a group of volunteers came forward to assist in cleaning up in between official ERYC street maintenance visits.

Since then Bourne Leisure at Thornwick Bay Holiday Village have kindly donated high visibility jackets and litter picking equipment to assist the team and they have already begun some excellent work in making Flamborough a village to be proud of for both residents and visitors alike.

The parish council would like to thank the group, led by Val Aitken, for their fantastic work and community spirit, as well as Councillor John Crossland for liaising with Bourne Leisure to provide the equipment.

Community Policing

Inspector Robert Cocker attended the May parish council meeting to discuss recent changes in local policing and to answer questions from councillors.

In the year ending December 2015 the crime rate in the East Riding was lower than the average crime rate across similar areas and was lower than the average for the Humberside force area.

Problems with the 101 non-emergency phone service have now been resolved following further changes in February 2016.

The police are actively encouraging members of the public to report all incidents of crime as public intelligence is often crucial in pursuing offenders and bringing criminal prosecutions.

Libraries Consultation

ERYC undertook a public consultation on whether savings could be made from the libraries budget. Nearly 8,000 took the opportunity to express their views and the findings from the consultation have been used to develop the proposal to:

- Retain a library or multi service centre in each major town or village in the East Riding but reduce opening hours
- Retain a mobile library service which would continue to deliver services across the East Riding but reduce the level of service
- Amalgamate the two libraries in Bridlington into one library - in line with other towns in the East Riding
- Invest £7.4 million in creating six more multi service centres

On 17 May 2016 The Cabinet gave permission to consult on this proposal.

The consultation will run from 25 May 2016 to 3 August 2016 and the questionnaire is available online at www.eastriding.gov.uk/proposalconsultation and paper versions are available at branch libraries, mobile libraries, multi service centres, customer service centres, leisure centres and children's centres

"COUNCIL CORNER"

March 2016:

- The council requested an assessment to be conducted into possible traffic calming measures on Tower Street. ERYC conducted this and submitted that the findings of the assessment concluded that unfortunately they could not recommend that any measure be put in place at this time.
- The council approved a request from Flamborough Pre-School to allow a section of village green to be enclosed for use as an outdoor play and learning area and will issue a licence to this effect. The meeting was very well attended with overwhelming support for the proposal.

April 2016:

- The Parish Council was notified that ERYC would consider the Community Governance Review Request at a meeting of full council on 6 April with the decision communicated in due course.
- The council approved the installation of a new street light on the corner of Allison Lane following the relocation of the existing Allison Lane street light to accommodate the Co-Op development and to ensure that the junction remains safe with adequate lighting.
- A new group of volunteers has been established to undertake litter picking around the village to supplement the service of ERYC.

May 2016 (Annual Council Meeting):

- Councillor Morton was elected Chairman for the year 2016-17.
- Councillor Sexton was elected Vice-Chairman for the year 2016-17.

May 2016:

- Inspector Robert Cocker of Humberside Police attended the meeting to discuss local community policing and answer questions from councillors.
- North Wolds Lions offered a donation of £200 to spend on a project to benefit the village in commemoration of the Queen's 90th Birthday. It was agreed that a bench in memory of Mary Sunley would be a fitting way to use the donation.
