Allotments

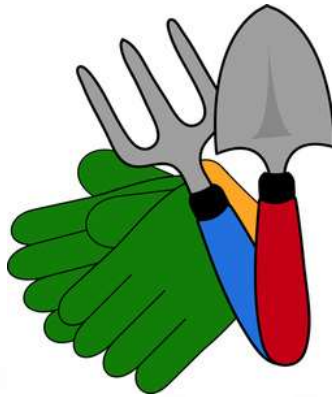
With the summer here why not get out into the fresh air and grow your own fresh vegetables, fruit, herbs and flowers? . Make friends with people who share your interest in gardening

You can find out what your IMEI number is by typing *#06# into your handset

You can then register your IMEI number, and details of other high value items, with Humberside Police to create your own account

"COUNCIL CORNER"

December 2017

- Following a request from ERYC, the Council sent a list of several suggested names to be used as street names when there are new developments in Flamborough.
- The Council agreed to Advanced Trees pruning the trees in Cameron Gardens and on the Village Green.

January 2018

- The Parish Council considered the budget, precept request and resultant impact to Council Tax payer for the 2018/19 year. £41360 will be needed to run village services which means an increase to Council Tax payers from £47.11 in 2017/18 to £48.55 in 2018/2019 based on a Band D property. This is an increase of 3%.
- The council agreed to a donation of £500 to Oswald's church to help with grass cutting.
- The Council listened to concerns and questions that residents has about the Fire Festival held on 31 December 2017 and agreed to contact ERYC about these concerns and add the issue to the agenda for February.

February 2018:

- The council listened to representations from the public and organisers of the Fire Festival about the event on New Year's Eve. They agreed to invite the festival committee to future meetings so that all residents could be kept informed of the plans for the next festival in 2018.
- The Council agreed in principle to entering into a Service Level Agreement with East Riding of Yorkshire Council for the maintenance of the street lighting in Flamborough.
- The Council agreed to repairs and maintenance for the Children's Playground on the Village Green.
- The Council agreed to the donation of a bench for the Village Green
